

Steps for Curriculum Compacting

Step One: Pre-Assessment

1. Determine pre-assessment and mastery expectations for students
2. Pre-assess students on one or more of the identified objectives before beginning instruction

Step Two: Modification of Learning Activities to Meet Student Needs

1. Identify students who have mastered the objectives or who have the potential to master them at faster than normal pace
2. Analyze whether identified students need enrichment or acceleration
3. Determine when identified students will be required to participate in whole group instruction
4. Determine timeline for introducing skills/concepts

Step Three: Provision of Alternative Learning Experiences

1. Collect or create enrichment or acceleration resources/materials
2. Create schedule of due date(s) and conferences to discuss student progress
3. Explain alternative learning activities to students
4. Evaluate student work
