



2014-15 BRUNSWICK ELEMENTARY ART GRADING POLICY 1ST GRADE

In first grade every student will receive two marks on for Art on all 4 report cards. They will receive a letter grade for their demonstration of skills and concepts and a numeric score for their effort. Below you will find more explanation for both scales. Demonstration of Skills and Concepts Scale:

EE = Exceeding Expectations of Grade Level Standards

Consistently meets and/or exceeds curriculum standards and class requirements

- Completes all projects neatly and creatively
- Completes all projects and written assignments by following all the guidelines
- Completes all projects to the best of the student's ability
- Masters all art concepts and skills taught
- Scores an average of 90% or better on all tests and quizzes
- Completes all self-grading rubrics correctly

ME = Meeting Expectations of Grade Level Standards

Frequently meets and/or exceeds curriculum standards and class requirements

- Completes all projects and written assignments
- Completes projects and written assignments by following most of the guidelines
- Completes most of the projects to the best of the student's individual ability
- Masters most of the art concepts and skills taught
- Scores an average of 80% or better on all tests and quizzes
- Completes all self-grading rubrics

AE = Approaching Expectations of Grade Level Standards

Generally meets curriculum standards and class requirements, though some curriculum standards and class requirements may remain as yet unmet

- Does not fully complete all projects and/or written assignments OR completes projects and written assignments, but does not follow all of the guidelines
- Completes some projects under the student's individual ability

- Scores an average of 70% on all tests and quizzes
- Masters some of the art concepts and skills taught
- Does not fully complete all self-grading rubrics or completes them incorrectly

DE = Developing Expectations of Grade Level Standards

Meets some curriculum standards and class requirements, though some curriculum standards and class requirements may remain as yet unmet

- Does not fully complete all projects and/or written assignments or completes projects and written assignments, but only follows some of the guidelines
- Completes some projects under the student's individual ability
- Scores an average of less than 70% on all tests and quizzes
- Masters few of the art concepts and skills taught
- Does not fully complete all self-grading rubrics or completes them incorrectly

Effort Scale:

The effort scale describes the student's level of commitment to tasks, class participation, quality and quantity of work, and timely completion of class and homework assignments.

4 = Consistently

3 = Most of the Time

2 = Inconsistently

1 = Rarely

0 = Not Demonstrating
