"B" AWARD GUIDELINES**

Specific Student Responsibilities

1. Each student is responsible for his/her "B" Award sheet. **KEEP IT IN A SAFE PLACE.**
2. **SCHOLARSHIP:** Each student will list the subjects taken. **Do not list grades** – your grades will be recorded and verified by the "B" Award committee.
3. **ATTENDANCE:** Attendance will be recorded after the "B" Award sheet is turned in by Mrs. Renn and Mrs. Moore.
4. **ACTIVITIES:** Each student will list the category and the activity he/she has participated in. See the list of acceptable activities attached. The sponsor should approve the activity by signing his/her name and the eligible number of points for this activity. (Please see the Maximum Point Scale for Activities.) **You must have the sponsor's signature before turning your application in.** An email from the sponsor will suffice. **Please put all emails with packet that you're turning in.**
5. Student "B" Award packets will be available online or in the Counseling Office on April 12 for seniors and May 14 for undergraduates. It will be the student's responsibility to adhere to proper procedures for collection.

Seniors: Return "B" Award Applications to Mrs. Renn by Monday, May 10, 2021.

Undergraduates: Return "B" Award Applications to Mrs. Renn by Friday, June 11, 2021.
6. Senior awards will be given prior to Graduation and undergraduate awards will be presented during the first semester of the next school year.

"B" AWARD MANUAL

I. SCHOLARSHIP:

A student must have a B average on the 4.0 system. A = 4 Points, B = 3 Points, C = 2 Points, D = 1 Point.

Students are responsible for entering the courses they are enrolled in for the current year. Final year grades will be recorded and verified by the "B" Award committee. This will be done after all final grades have been awarded to students.

Minimum Grade Point Average 3.0

II. ATTENDANCE

A student must acquire a minimum of 18 points. The point scale for attendance is as follows:

- 3 points per month for perfect attendance
- 2 points per month for attendance with only lawful absences
- 0 points per month for any illegal absence

Minimum Points 18

III. ACTIVITIES

A student must accumulate at least 30 points in a minimum of three different categories from the point scale on student's activities listed on the attached page. Points may also be received for any activity in which a student participates that is not listed on the attached page, which requires at least 10 hours of preparation and is presented to the public as a Brunswick High School activity. Any activity, which meets this requirement and is not listed in the "B" Award Manual, will be awarded points by the "B" Award committee. Students involved in clubs, organizations or athletic teams should only receive points if they followed through the committed length of time needed to be a member in good standing. **If it was impossible to be involved in activities during this past school year, please write a three-paragraph essay stating how COVID affected you personally and how you helped others during this pandemic.**

Minimum Point 30

IV. BEHAVIOR

A student may have no major office referrals or any suspensions. If he has received either, then this will eliminate the student from further consideration for an award.

- VII. Other Activities or three-paragraph essay stating how COVID affected you and how you helped others during this pandemic.**

Student is to write a brief descriptive paragraph on the activity, which includes the time, place, and sponsoring adult. Point value will be determined by the "B" Award Committee with the recommendation of the sponsoring adult. The sponsoring adult should initial the paragraph. The activity should be outside the regular school day and not be a part of classroom assignments.
