Admission Requirements:

Eligible students seeking admission to courses offered through the dual enrollment program must:

- Complete the FCPS College and Career Readiness Dual Enrollment Application;
- Complete the college application for admission;
- Meet the prerequisites for the course(s);
- Complete diagnostic assessment or have appropriate scores on SAT, ACT or PARCC assessments that indicate readiness for college level work as determined by the college;
 - A grade of B or higher in Algebra 2 or subsequent math courses taken during the junior year indicates readiness for college level mathematics; and
- Provide confirmation regarding eligibility for Free and Reduced Meals
