This year we will be awarding a total of \$7,500 in multiple scholarships to:

1. Students attending a four-year college pursuing a Bachelor's Degree
2. Students attending a community college 2-year program pursuing an Associate Degree or other certification
3. Students attending a trade or technical school

To be eligible for these scholarships, a student:

1. Must be a U.S. Citizen
2. Must currently reside in Frederick County
3. Must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited U.S. college, university, or technical school for the 2019-2020 school year at the time the scholarship funds are provided
4. Must NOT have an immediate family member who is a Rotarian

To be considered, an applicant must submit the following:

1. Completed application form, attached hereto
2. An official copy of your high school transcript including any college courses you took while in high school.
3. A copy of any test scores (SAT, ACT, TOEFL) used to qualify for admission to a post-secondary institution
4. Short essay questions, attached hereto
 - a. In 200 words or less, please share your post-high school educational objectives and subsequent goals
 - b. In 200 words or less, specify a dollar amount, **up to \$2,500**, and how you would use those funds to achieve the greatest impact on your ability to enter into the post-secondary studies of your choice. Note: You may request funds for tuition, books, room & board, tools of your trade, or other items specific to your educational plan
 - c. Rotary's motto is **"Service above Self,"** in 200 words or less, tell us how you feel you embody service above self in your life and your community

To submit your application:

The application, short essay responses, and supporting materials should be submitted as one PDF document titled: "LastName, FirstName_RCCCS2019" to scholarships@carrollcreekrotary.org with the subject line: "RCCCS2019".

To combine multiple files into one PDF using Adobe:

1. Within Adobe Acrobat, click on the Tools menu and select Combine Files
2. Click Combine Files, and then click Add Files to select the files you want to include in your PDF.
3. Click, drag, and drop to reorder the files and pages
4. When finished arranging files, click Combine Files
