Career Options:

With a 4-year college degree: Cosmetology Teacher, Salon or Spa Manager, Cosmetic Chemist, Beauty Editor of Magazine, Dermatologist/Trichologist (w/ higher degree)

With a 2-year college/technical school: Platform Artist (On stage teaching professional stylists latest trends), Make-up Artist (Stage/TV), Color Specialist, and Nail Specialist

Direct entry into the workforce: Stylist, Nail Technician

Overview: The Cosmetology Program is a two-year (1,500 hour) program, the purpose of this course is to train the student in the basic manipulative skills, safety judgments, proper work habits and desirable attitudes necessary to obtain licensure and for competency in entry level positions in cosmetology, one of the most diversified, fastest growing industries in the world today.

Value Added:

- ❖ Students are prepared to take The Maryland State Board of Cosmetology Exam allowing them to earn their Maryland State Cosmetology License.

Application Process: Current 10th grade students should schedule a shadow visit through their home school guidance counselor. The shadowing experience provides the students with an overview of the program allowing them to determine if the program matches their career goals. The instructor evaluates the student's aptitude and interest through written and hands-on evaluation. Students receive an application at the time of shadowing, which must be signed by their parents and guidance counselor and returned to CTC. In addition to interest and aptitude, the student's grades and attendance are taken into consideration.
