Activities to Try at Home

Math

The Shape of Things

Have your child look around your house for as many different kinds of shapes as he/she can discover. Your child could record the different objects he/she found and what shape they were. Look for 2-D and 3-D shapes. Examples: clock – circle, door – rectangle, ball – sphere, can - cylinder

Have your child tell you the attributes of the shapes. Examples: A triangle has 3 sides and 3 corners. A circle has no sides and is round. A square has 4 corners and 4 sides that are equal lengths.

Language Arts

CVC Words

1. Say simple CVC (consonant/vowel/consonant) words and have your child tell you each sound in the word. For example, if you say the word “cat”, your child should tell you the sounds are /c/a/t/.
2. Say a CVC word and then have your child change the initial or final letter to make a new word. For example, make the word “cat” and change it to “can”.
