

## Questions to Ask Your Reader – Intermediate

You can help your child be a better reader by reading with your child and asking questions about the reading. Below are questions to guide you in supporting your child's reading.

### For students in grades 3-5:

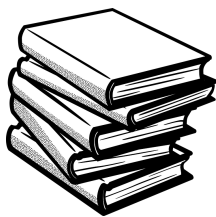
For fiction books:

- What are 2 or 3 sentences that summarize what you are reading?
- What lesson do you think the main character learned? Why?
- What is the author trying to teach you?

For nonfiction books:

- What are the most important ideas in your reading?
- What new information did you learn? How can this information help you?
- Do you think the author used fact or opinion when writing this text? Why?

\*Asking a follow up question such as "Why do you think that?" will allow your children to feel confident in their answer and will allow opportunities for discussion.
