

## Questions to Ask Your Reader - Primary

You can help your child be a better reader by reading with your child and asking questions about the reading. Below are questions to guide you in supporting your child's reading.

**For students in prek through second grade:**

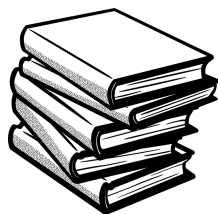
For fiction books:

- What is the story mostly about?
- Who is the most important character? Why?
- What is the most important part of the story? Why?
- What is the author trying to teach you?

For nonfiction books:

- What is your reading mostly about?
- What was the author's purpose? Why did he or she write this text?
- What questions do you still have after reading?

\*Asking a follow up question such as "Why do you think that?" will allow your children to feel confident in their answer and will allow opportunities for discussion.
