WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I is a federally funded program offering schools additional staff and/or resources to support student achievement.

The Title I program supports academic activities detailed in the school's School Improvement Plan.

WHY DO SCHOOLS RECEIVE TITLE I SUPPORT?

The Federal government provides funding to schools with the hope of "leveling the playing field" for all students and families.

Schools are identified for Title I based on their percentage of students receiving free and reduced priced meals.

HOW DOES TITLE I HELP OUR SCHOOL?

Title I provides additional staffing and instructional resources to enhance the academic programs at our school.
