

Hybrid at Oakdale High - Frequently Asked Student Questions

- 1. How do I know where I will be catching the bus during hybrid learning?**
 - In order to determine what bus your student is scheduled to ride, along with pickup and drop off times, please go to the following online link: fcps.org/transportation/bus-stop-information-online
 - Click on "Bus Stop Information". Enter your street number in the first block, followed by your street name in the second block, then click "Submit." Pickup and drop off times should appear on the next screen with appropriate bus route number.
- 2. Where is my teacher's room?**
 - Use the [first floor](#) and [second floor](#) maps to find each teacher's room. Remember, most teachers changed rooms over the summer, so even returning students may want to take a look.
- 3. Which staircases are we allowed to use to switch between the 1st to the 2nd floors?**
 - Students may access the four large staircases (in the corners) of the A and B wings. They CANNOT use the smaller staircases between the A and B wings. Each staircase is marked with arrows telling you which side is for students going up and which is for going down.



- 4. What is the updated schedule starting on Tuesday, 2/16?**
 - During hybrid, SET will be shortened on hybrid learning days. Click [here](#) to see the schedule.
- 5. Where do I enter the building in the morning?**
 - There will be three entrances open to students in the morning. Students riding a bus will enter from the back entrance (near the health room). Student drivers will enter in through the front doors. Students being dropped off by a parent will enter via the side entrance (cafeteria). Make sure your mask is on when you enter the building.
- 6. Where do I go once I enter the building?**
 - Once you enter the building, you will go directly to your 1st block class. The only exception would be students who would like to eat breakfast. Those students will go to the cafeteria.
- 7. How do I meet with my SET class on hybrid days?**
 - Students will NOT move rooms during SET and will remain in their second block classes. Each hybrid student will log-in to their SET teacher's Google Meet (just as was done previously). It is

recommended that you bring a pair of headphones with you during hybrid, so you can listen to your Meet without distracting the other students.

8. When do I eat lunch?

- a. Lunch shifts are determined by your 4th block class. During virtual, we've all been eating from 11:00 - 11:30 am. Now, some students will eat during the earlier shifts. Students who are virtual, will log-out during lunch, and return to the Google Meet afterwards. Below are the subjects (and some individual teachers) who eat each lunch shift.

9. If I don't want to eat lunch in the cafeteria, where can I go?

- a. If you are not eating (meaning your mask will be on), you are allowed to go to the auditorium during lunch and sit socially distanced from other students. All students who plan to eat, must report to the cafeteria.

10. Do I need to bring a laptop/chromebook with me during hybrid learning?

- a. Yes. OHS was using devices for one-to-one learning long before there was a pandemic. Teachers will expect students to be able to access online materials and tools during hybrid.

11. What are the rules about bathrooms during hybrid?

- a. Bathrooms will be closed during class changes. During classes, teachers will only be letting ONE student leave the room at a time to use the bathroom. Each bathroom has a sign indicating the maximum number of students allowed to be in it at a time.

12. Will we have access to water fountains?

- a. You will be able to fill up cups and water bottles using the building's water fountains, but you will NOT be able to drink from them directly.

13. How are AM and PM CTC handled?

- a. Morning CTC students will catch their bus around 7:20 am in the bus lot (back of school). PM CTC students will catch the bus in the cafeteria at 10:00 am and will eat during SET.

14. Should I bring headphones with me to school?

- a. Yes! When you are in a room with others, you may want to access a Google Meet with sound. For example, you may be working in a group with virtual students or listening to your SET teacher. Headphones will allow you to listen to a Meet without playing the sound to the entire class.

15. What do we do in the afternoon after we are back home from hybrid learning?

- a. In the afternoons, you should be working on the assignments you need to complete for your classes. Teachers will be available to help students from 1:30 - 2:30 pm in the afternoons, as needed.

16. In middle school, we weren't allowed to carry backpacks. Can we have them here?

- a. Yes, students are allowed to carry backpacks at OHS. Students will NOT be allowed to use lockers during hybrid learning.

17. Will students have access to the media center?

- a. Students can stay in the library if they do not have a scheduled class (e.g., FCC Dual Enrollment students, students with a part-time schedule, work-study/internship students, etc.). All students in the media center will be required to sign in via QR code with the new LibraryTrac system. It is requested that students who want to check out materials use [Online browsing and putting books on hold](#) for pick up.

18. Are free meals available during hybrid?

- a. Yes. The FCPS free meals program will resume on Tuesday, 2/16 for all students in school buildings on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Free breakfasts and lunches will be available to children in cohort A on Mondays and Tuesdays and to children in cohort B on Thursdays and Fridays. On days when students are learning in a school building, they may also take a free, to-go meal for dinner that same day.
