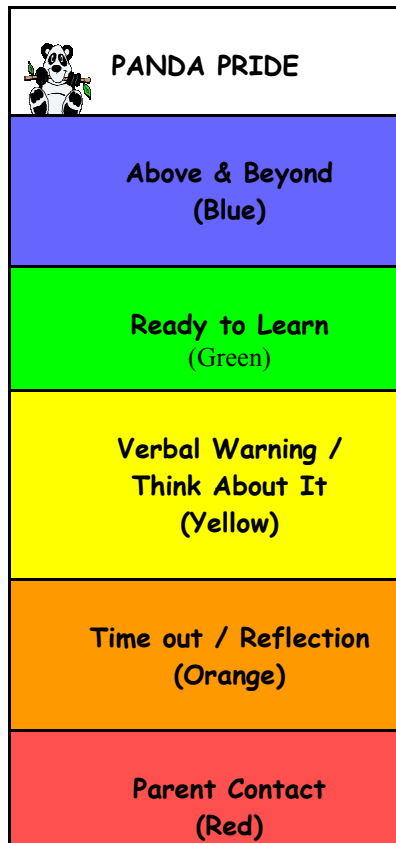


School Wide Behavior Management Tool

Parkway utilizes a color coded school wide behavior management system. Students are recognized for their positive behavior throughout the day. The chart provides a visual reminder for how students can change their behavior.



Student Consequences for Inappropriate Behavior

- Student Reflection

The purpose of a student reflection is to identify what school rule was violated. Then together the teacher and student brainstorm problem solving steps so that students can show positive behavior at school. Parents will be provided a copy of the completed reflection.

- Minor Behavior Incident Report

An individual conference between a student and staff member will be held to make the student aware of his/her poor judgment regarding a particular incident. This will provide the opportunity for discussing possible alternatives available for the student to correct the problem. Parent contact will occur for each Minor. Students will bring the Minor home for parent signature.

- Referral to Administration

Faculty members will complete a referral form when the behavior needs to be handled by an administrator, The administrator will investigate the incidents and determine appropriate action to resolve the issue.

What does PBIS Mean?

PBIS is an acronym for Positive Behaviors Interventions and Supports. The PBIS program is based upon our philosophy of recognizing positive contributions of students. Our goal is to help each child develop self-discipline. Together the home and school share the responsibility for developing good citizens. Parents, teachers, and students must work together to maintain a safe learning environment.

PBIS means that students will know exactly what is expected of them. Students who take responsibility to behave positively will be recognized and rewarded in a variety of ways. Students will also know exactly what consequences will result when they choose NOT to meet the school-wide expectations .

Student Rewards for Appropriate Behavior

1. Panda Points

Panda Points are positive behavior incentives that are given to students by any adult at Parkway Elementary School. All staff members will recognize students who show respect with Panda Points!



2. Weekly Panda Point Raffle

As students earn Panda Points they are entered into a classroom raffle. Each week a ticket is chosen at random to win classroom level incentives.



3. Panda Café Fine Dining

Based on daily cafeteria behavior, grades may earn stars. When 3 stars are earned, a special treat is provided.



4. Character Education Celebration

Awards will be presented at the celebration, for attendance & displaying good character traits.
