## As a School, we will:

- Build a relationship with every family by providing ongoing communication by newsletter, email, conferences (October 23, 24, 25), and phone calls regarding student's academic progress and behavior.
- Provide a welcoming and safe educational environment for all students.
- Use data to effectively plan for and differentiate instruction for students.
- Encourage family involvement by inviting families to volunteer and participate in school events.

## As Families, we will:

- Ensure our child arrives to school on time and ready to learn.
- Regularly discuss the school day with our child and check folders and book bags.
- Make sure that homework is completed every night and encourage positive study skills.
- Provide accurate and updated phone numbers and emergency information to the office.
- Read daily to/or with our child and use math problem-solving in our everyday routines.

## As a Student, I will:

- Always follow the school rules by being safe, respectful, responsible, and successful.
- Participate in class and share my learning daily with my family.
- Complete all classroom assignments with excellence.
- Be responsible and bring home information from the school.
- Read daily to/or with a family member and practice math problem-solving with my family.

## Family Involvement

### Building Capacity for Family Involvement

- Flyers and information sent home will be in English and Spanish, when applicable, and will assist families with monitoring their child’s progress.
- Families will receive information about their rights as Title I parents and State and FCPS Academic Standards every fall. This year this information was shared at our Open House. Copies are always available at the front office.
- Families will have the opportunity to participate in events coordinated with our school and the local community (for example, Judy Center, FCPS English Language Learner program and the local health department).
- Waverley Elementary School will provide assistance and reasonable accommodations, such as interpreters, to parents upon request. Contact the front office at 240-236-3900.

### Program Development

- Families and school staff will develop and commit to a Family/School compact which describes how school staff, parents, and students will share responsibility for improving student achievement.
- Families will have opportunities to provide continuous, on-going feedback through surveys about various aspects of our elementary school’s Title I program, such as the family involvement plan, budget, compact, session times, and topics.
- Families will have opportunities to provide feedback to educate school personnel on how to work with parents as equal partners in their child’s educational process.

### Family Involvement Activities

All families are invited to attend morning, afternoon, and evening Parents as Partner events which may include, but not be limited to- STEM Night, Literacy Nights, Math Nights, and Table Talks. Families will receive materials and instruction which will help make learning fun and enjoyable. **Parents will find out about family engagement activities through paper invitations on Golden Rod paper and electronic reminders on Schoology, Find Out First, and our School’s website.**
