Health Tips

Being a fit kid!

Being fit is a way of saying a person [eats well](#), gets a lot of physical activity ([exercise](#)), and has a healthy weight. If you're fit, your body works well, feels good, and can do all the things you want to do, like run around with your friends.

1. Eat a variety of foods.
 - a. Eat at least five servings of fruits and vegetables a day – two fruits and three vegetables.
2. Drink water and milk.
 - a. When you're really thirsty, cold [water](#) is the best thirst-quencher. And there's a reason your school cafeteria offers cartons of milk. Kids need calcium to build strong bones, and milk is a great source of this mineral.
3. Listen to your body.
 - a. When you're eating, notice how your body feels and when your stomach feels comfortably full.
4. Limit screen time.
 - a. What's screen time? It's the amount of time you spend watching TV or DVDs, playing video games (console systems or handheld games), and using a smartphone, tablet, or computer. The more time you spend on these sitting-down activities, the less time you have for active stuff, like basketball, bike riding, and swimming. Try to spend no more than 2 hours a day on screen time, not counting computer use related to school and educational activities.
5. Be active!!
 - a. Take a walk, ride our bike (with a helmet), go for a run, play basketball or soccer, get moving!
