Health Tips

School-Based Health Centers

Getting health care for your child can be complicated. Many doctors only offer appointments during the school day, and their offices might be far from school. To see the doctor, your child might have to miss school and you might have to leave work – which isn't always an option.

School-based health centers make going to the doctor much more simple.

The School-Based Health Center (SBHC) housed at Hillcrest Elementary School, offers medical care and treatment for all students enrolled in the program. Medical care may include examinations, sports physicals, immunizations, preventative care, and treatment of illnesses. In addition, the School-Based Health Center can serve as the “medical home” for students that do not have health insurance. To enroll in the SBHC, see our school's health room technician or visit the center behind Hillcrest Elementary school. The center is open Tuesday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with some evening hours. To schedule an appointment or for more information, please call the SBHC at 240-236-3275.
